1. One e of a large class built by 3 Maj for USSR; here in Latvian Shipping colours. By length of name, would go with KEMERI (built 1985 as YULIY DANISHEVSKIY.
Agree, in Dover Straits.
2. STENA INVICTA – definitely at Dover.
- 3 GORLITZ (DSR owned). Built 1974, broken up 1999 as NIKOLAS K. Alongside at IJmuiden
4. HUGO (registered MARIEHAMN). OBO built 1965 as BERGELAND. BrokZn up in 1993 as UGO. Possibly at Antwerp.
- 5 ALI BABA – coaster. Built 1983 at Wewelsfleth. Currently trading as MIKA. Appears to be in Antwerp.
- 6 PYTCHLEY (P&O). Built 1980 as NORTHERN GALE. Broken up Chittagong in 2000 as ALLEGRA.
- 7 ABEILLE NO. 7 is seen at Le Havre.

- No 1 Products tanker in Latvian tankers colours
- No. 2 STENA INVICTA Operated under UK flag 1991-2000 still working now for Color Line as COLOR VIKING she was built as PEDERS PAAR in 1985
- No. 3 East German bulk carrier GRODITZ built Leningrad 1972 sold in 1993 and renamed THEO B broken up 1999 Alang
- No. 4 HUGO built at Stavanger 1965 as BERGELAND as HUGO operated by Lundquist Shipping Co Ltd, of **Mariehamn**, Finland.
1993 renamed UGO for voyage to Chinese shipbreakers
- No. 5 AL BABA built Peters Wewelsfleth German in 1983 now MIKA under Danish ownership
- No. 7 ABEILLE No 7 worked Le Havre from 1972 - 2003 sold to Cote D'ivoire and renamed KOTIBA not seen on AIS 3936 days!!
