#### **CRUISE SHIP NEWS - OCTOBER**

- VIRGIN VOYAGES Virgin is to drop Portsmouth as its U.K. based port from 2027. This news come as a bit of a shock, as previously reported, Portsmouth is the only port in the world to receive all four ships. However Virgin will now focus on fly-cruise to make Eastern Europe ports more accessible for their 'sailors'.
- MSC MERAVIGLIA Will sail from Southampton between May and October 2027, offering 19 cruises ranging from six to fourteen nights. MSC Virtuosa will complete her ex-UK season next year and then move to Barcelona for summer 2027. In winter 2026/27, MSC Preziosa will replace MSC Poesia in Southampton.
- MARINER OF THE SEAS will be based in Southampton for the first time in 2027. The Royal Caribbean ship will sail a range of two- to nine-night itineraries including the Norwegian fjords, Porto, Copenhagen and Seville.

#### **CRUISE SHIPS IN FOCUS** - Current inactive Cruise Ships! - Adam Ratcliffe

This month's cruise focus is inactive cruise ships searching for a new home. Currently, there are a few inactive cruise ships still in service, listed below in age order. These ships are waiting for an operator or will eventually be scrapped. In the notation box, **I've listed the last company operator first, and then a brief description of the vessel's current status**. I hope this helps those who keep records, or simply ensures theirs are in order.

Ship Name	Built	Tons	S	P	$\boldsymbol{L}$	Notes
FUNCHAL	1961	9,563gt	16	524	153	Ex Funchal (Portuscale Cruises) 2013-2015 Brought by Brock Pierce US businessman to convert to hotel ship in 2021 for €1.6million euro. <b>LAID UP, Lisbon 2015/6-present.</b>
OCEAN MAJESTY	1965	10,417gt	18	540	135	Ex Ocean Majesty (Hansa Touristik) 2013-2023 Still owned by Majestic International Cruises. Retired in 2023, and since then she's been used as asylum seeker accommodation in Velsen-Noord, Netherlands. The contract was due to end in August 2025, but a deal extension was recently signed to keep the vessel until July 1, 2026. The new contract includes another extension option, which could see the ship continuing to serve as floating accommodations through December 31, 2026.
EXPEDITION	1972	6,334gt	17	134	105	Ex Expedition (GAP Adventures) 2008-2025 Although no official announcements about the future (there are rumours she may be sold to breakers). She is currently laid up alongside "Serenissima", Poland. So there is a possibility that the ex-Dover-Boulogne ferry may be acquired by Vestland Classics for potential Baltic and Arctic-Svalbard cruises. Wait and see
AEGEAN ODYSSEY	1973	11,906gt	18	380	140	Ex Aegean Odyssey (Road Scholar) 2020-2022 Charter to RoadScholar terminated in 2022 due to engine trouble. Announced in May 2025 that new Greek start up 'Grand Odyssey Cruises' would operate her starting in July. However no sign of operation as of yet. LAID UP - Piraeus, Greece, 2022-present.
BERLIN OCEANIS	1981	9,750gt	18	462	126	Ex Berlin (FTI Cruises) 2012-2020 FTI Cruises ceased operations in 2020 due to the pressure of covid. The ship was sold to become a private yacht! However after being remanded <i>Dream Princess</i> court cases with Princess Cruises finally put this into administration. A new company Berlin Capital Group have started to convert her into a casino for cruises out of Penang, Malaysia. Currently there seems to be little activity since May! Currently in Panang, Malaysia.
MINERVA	1989	12,892gt	15	350	113	Ex Minerva (Swan Hellenic) 2008-2017 Inactive since the fall of All Leisure Group in 2017. Plans to convert her into a private yacht came to nothing. There was a rumour she would operate for Hansa Touristik however they decided to shut down. LAID UP - Elefsis, Greece, 2017-present.
VIDANTAWORLDS ELEGANT	1990	15,343gt	18	556	150	Ex Voyager (Voyages of Discovery) 2012-2017 Currently waiting to start operations in Genoa, Italy. Has been laid up since being sold and has had three different names in this time. She has been majorly overhauled and marketed as a luxury yacht. LAID UP - Mazatland, Mexico 2017-2025
MANTRA	1990	4,203gt	16	100	88	Ex Silver Galapagos (Silversea Expeditions) 2013-2021 Built as Renaissance Three, & sold after Silversea took delivery of Silver Origin, 2021. <b>LAID UP, Panama 2021-present.</b>
MAJESTY OF THE OCEANS	1992	74,941gt	22	2,767	270	Ex Majesty of the Seas (Royal Caribbean Int.) 1992-2020 Part of the SeaJets fleet that got purchased during the pandemic. LAID UP - Piraeus & Elefsis, Greece, 2020-present.
AEGEAN MAJESTY	1996	57,092gt	21	1,350	219	Ex Veendam (Holland America Line) 1996-2020 Sold by Carnival Corporation as part of thier cull on unwanted tonnage, to SeaJets. She has remained laid up ever since. LAID UP - Aigio, Greece, 2020-present.
CHINESE TAISHAN	2000	24,427gt	30	927	181	Ex Chinese Taishan (Bohai Ferry Company) 2014-2020 Has been out of service since the pandemic, however little information is available about the current status of the ship.
QUEEN OF THE OCEANS	2000	77,499gt	22	2,272	261	Ex Oceana (P&O Cruises) 2002-2020 Sold by Carnival Corporation as part of thier cull on unwanted tonnage, to SeaJets. She has remained laid up ever since. LAID UP - Piraeus & Elefsis, Greece, 2020-present.
BLUE DREAM STAR	2001	24,318gt	30	1,053	180	Ex Glory Sea (Diamond Cruises International) 2016-2020 Like her sister little information to say if she's active or not!
GODDESS OF THE NIGHT	2003	102,784gt	20	2,718	272	Ex Costa Magica (SeaJets) 2023-2024 SeaJets having brought the ship from Costa Cruises, renamed her Goddess of the Night for their 'Neoynx Cruises' brand. Unfortunately there was not enough bookings to keep her active. LAID UP - Elefsis, Greece, 2024-present.
GOLDEN HORIZON	2021	8,770gt	16	272	162	Ex Golden Horizon (Tradewind Voyages) 2021 The ship was ordered as Flying Clipper but due to a dispute with the shipyard she was never delivered to Star Clippers. Tradewind Voyages chartered her from the builders but the Croatian company that owned her has gone into administration.  LAID UP - Split, Croatia 2021-present.


